**LOCATION:** The Kravis Center, 701 Okeechobee Boulevard, West Palm Beach, FL

**TICKET INFORMATION:** Tickets will **ONLY** be sold on the dates listed above. Juniors and seniors may purchase tickets for themselves and for **one guest age 20 or younger** from Ms. Farris in room 2-134. In order to purchase a ticket, the registration card must be completed in its entirety. All WHS students must have a stamp indicating that they are clear of obligations!

If you purchase tickets online before you clear obligations, you will not receive a refund nor will you be allowed to attend prom.

Tickets may be purchased before school, during lunch and 7<sup>th</sup> hour and after school in 2-134. Payment may be made online through school cash. The price online goes up at the end of the day of the last Friday in the payment window. If you pay online, you will print out your receipt and bring the registration page (with cleared obligations) to Ms. Farris in 2-134. You will not have a ticket until your paperwork (properly filled out) is submitted to Ms. Farris. No refunds will be given after March 29th.

Please note that any student suspended from school for a Level 3 or Level 4 offense is not permitted to attend prom. Level 3 and Level 4 offenses include actions such as fighting, verbal assault, battery, stealing, vandalism, alcohol – drugs – tobacco, false fire alarm, lewd or obscene acts, weapon possessions, etc.

**GUEST POLICY:** A current Palm Beach public high school student does not need a background check. Guests from either a **public** or a **private** high schools do **not** need a background check, but the guest must procure a letter from the headmaster/principal of their schools (on school letterhead) that testifies to their satisfactory behavior. This letter must be attached to the prom registration paper. Write your information on the top of the page and then write the guest name, student number (if applicable) and school name with phone number. Guests must be age twenty (20) or younger. All other guests, including those who graduated in 2018 must undergo a criminal background check as stipulated on the "Prom Guest Policy Information" handout. All non-WHS guests must submit their paperwork (as noted above) when the WHS Junior/Senior date purchases both tickets. Guests may not purchase individual tickets.

**DRESS CODE:** Prom attire is either formal or semi-formal. Dresses with extremely plunging necklines or backs or with excessively revealing cut-outs may not be worn. Additionally, guests may not wear or carry hats and canes. Guests are responsible for the security of their personal items (purses, phones, cameras, etc.) at all times.

**ARRIVAL:** Upon arrival to the Kravis Center, all attendees will be checked (and “wanded”) prior to entry. Once inside, each student and guest will need to provide photographic identification (driver’s license or school I.D.) and your ticket for entry. (*Invitations are souvenirs only--you will need to bring your numbered ticket with you..*) **Only students on the prom guest list will be permitted entry.**

**Tickets are not transferable to another person** without Ms.Farris’ and administration consent prior to prom (this would be in writing).

Since this is a school function, **all participants are required to adhere to the school’s rules of conduct.** Any participant who arrives under the influence of alcohol or any illegal substance will not be permitted entry; furthermore, the individual will be detained until his/her parents arrive. Any student detained for this reason will be denied a refund and become subject to disciplinary action at school.

All participants will be searched for illegal substances or weapons. **NO VAPES, JULES OR OTHER SIMILAR ITEMS ARE ALLOWED.** THEY WILL BE CONFISCATED AND YOU WILL RECEIVE CONSEQUENCES FOR BRINGING SUCH ITEMS TO A SCHOOL EVENT.

**Once a participant leaves prom, she/he may not reenter for any reason.**

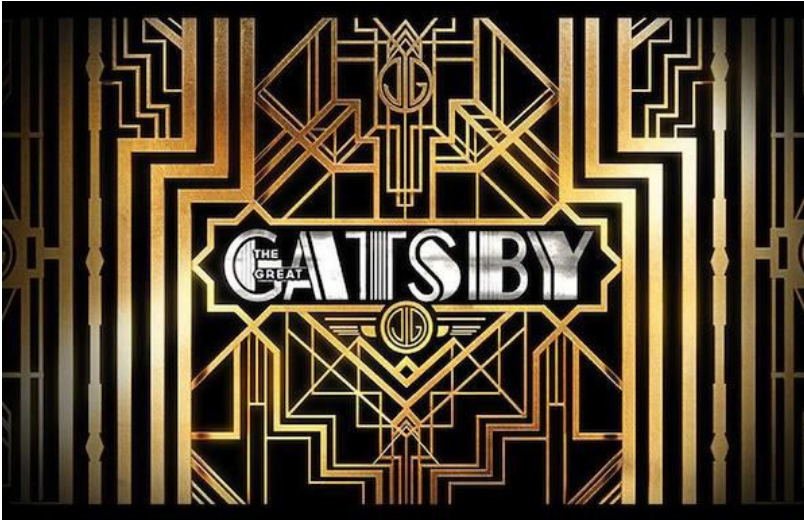
**MUSIC:** Music may be requested during prom. The DJ will have an area set up to accept requests.

All attendees should plan to spend at least a couple of hours at the prom. The dance floor provides ample dancing space, and this year’s DJ will feature an enhanced sound system. There will be a photo booth with props for you and your friends to take pictures. There will also be one area that will be for a formal photo. You will receive your ticket for your formal photo when you check in. Appetizers and desserts will be served buffet style throughout the evening. Appetizers and desserts may include: Chicken Tenders, Quesadillas, Mini-Hamburgers, Vegetable Tray, Mozzarella Sticks, Cookies, Fudge Brownies, and Cupcakes.

**PROM COURT:** Students may run for Prom King and Prom Queen. Nominations will be accepted during the week of February 25 Voting for Prom Court will occur during the week of March 11th. Court will be announced at 10:00 pm followed by the Crowning of the King and Queen.

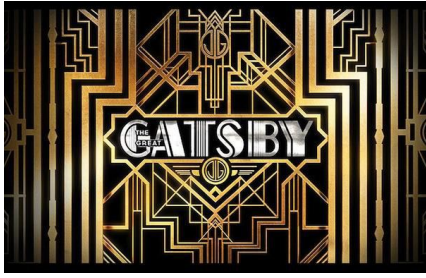
